

## Stupid Something

The Ready To Play Style “Stupid Something” is based on an Easy Listening 8 Beat Style and made for playing the Song “Something Stupid” by C. Carson Parks.

The most famous recording of the song probably is the version of Frank Sinatra together with his daughter Nancy Sinatra.

Since then the song has been recorded in many versions, also without singers, just as instrumentals.

Many years later the song became famous again, even for the young generation, due to the successful recording of Robbie Williams and Nicole Kidman.

In this document you will find how to use the RTP Style, and which One Touch Program should be used for which part of the song.

I started by selecting the Internal Style “Cool Pop”.

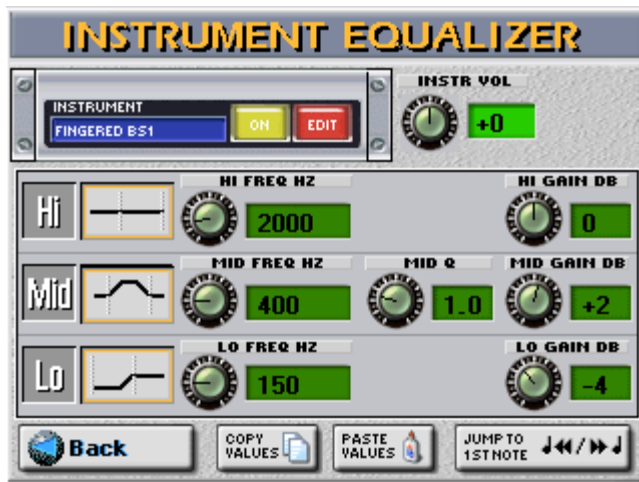
Then I copied all the Drums from the Style “Beguine” into the Style “Cool Pop” using the Style Composer.



Then I went into the Style Make Up Tools for changing some sounds and for adjusting levels to suit the modified sound texture.



Every Sound can be equalized for keeping the Style transparent.



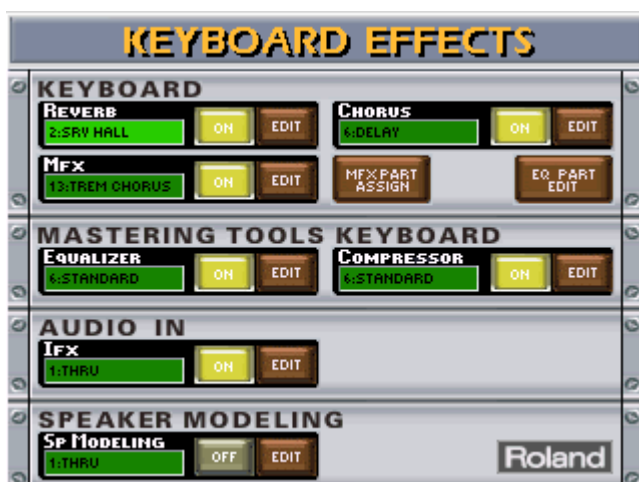
From there I set the focus on the Melody Sounds. (Please refer to Playing Instructions)

Now, the most important parts in creating high quality Registration Data begin:

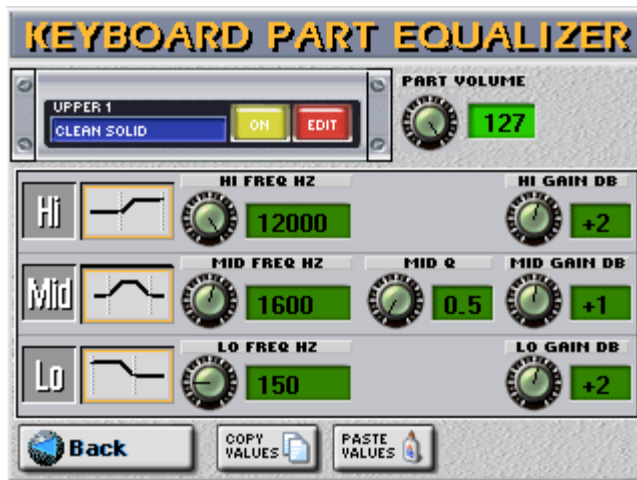
The Mixing.



The selection and adjustment of nice Effects like Reverb, Chorus, Delay, etc ...



For the final adjustment I even used the individual Part Equalizer. This helps keeping the Sound transparent, clear and still warm and gentle.



### Playing Instructions:

The MA Program (Music Assistant User Program) “Stupid Something” is featuring a nice Electric Guitar Sound for playing some Fills into the Introduction of the Song.

OTP 1 is using a beautiful Soft Clarinet Sound for playing the Verse.

OTP 2 is featuring a Flute and an Acoustic Guitar. Here you can play the 2 Voices that are so typical for the Arrangement of this Song.

OTP 3 is using Strings Orchestra with a slight Focus on the Celli for playing the 2<sup>nd</sup> Verse of the Song.

OTP 4 is using a powerful Full Strings Orchestra with a Solo Trumpet on top.

You can hear the result by listening to the mp3 Sound Example.

I hope you enjoy playing with my RTP Styles as much as I do.
