Cautions after an exporting into G-70!!!

When all files have been copied, drag the "G-70_SSD" icon to the recycle bin (or use the equivalent shortcut).

Wait until the icon has disappeared from your desktop.

On the G-70, press the [EXIT] button or [DISCONNECT] field.

An inappropriate disconnection can cause a loss of data.

Software Requirements.

G-70 Database Manager requires Mac ® OS X v10.2 or later.

G-70 Database Manager runs on Java ® runtime environment, version 1.4.2 or later.

If you are running any of these operating systems with Java ® runtime environment your system has already met all the requirements necessary to run G-70 Database Manager.

An installation of G-70 Database Manager requires 7.2Mbyte of hard drive space.

Mac OS X ® installation instructions.

1. Double-click on **G-70DatabaseManager1.1.dmg**.
An **G-70DatabaseManager1.1** drive icon image appears in your desktop.
2. Double-click on **G-70DatabaseManager1.1** drive icon image to open .
3. Select the **G-70DatabaseManager** folder and copy, by drag & drop, on your desktop or other location.
4. To create a shortcut on your desktop, open, by double-click, the **G-70DatabaseManager** folder.
5. Select the G-70 Database Manager1.1 icon application.
6. Press the Apple key and then the "L" key. A G-70 Database Manager1.1 alias was created.
7. Move, by drag & drop, the G-70 Database Manager1.1 alias file on your desktop.
8. To start the application make a double-click on G-70 Database Manager1.1 shortcut icon.

If G-70 Database Manager doesn't run.

If you have problem running G-70 Database Manager probably in your computer there isn't an Java ® runtime environment or there isn't an appropriate version. Please download a Java ® runtime environment from the following link suited to your computer environment.
